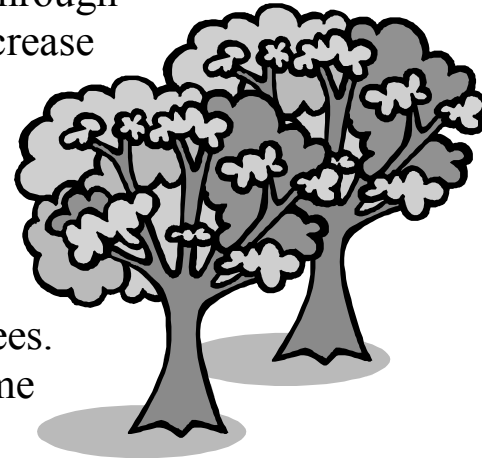

Oak Wilt disease is slowly spreading through NE Michigan. We have noticed an increase this summer of diseased trees.

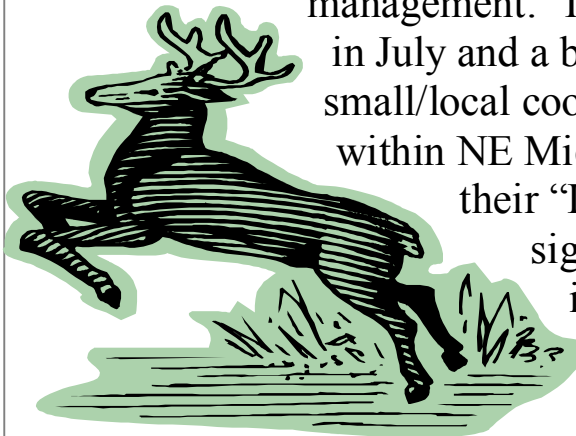
Diseased trees display brown and curling leaves that eventually fall to the ground during the summer.
